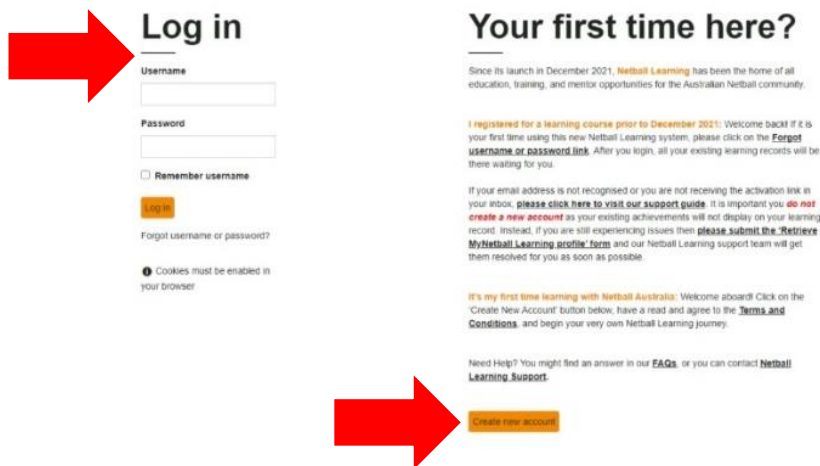
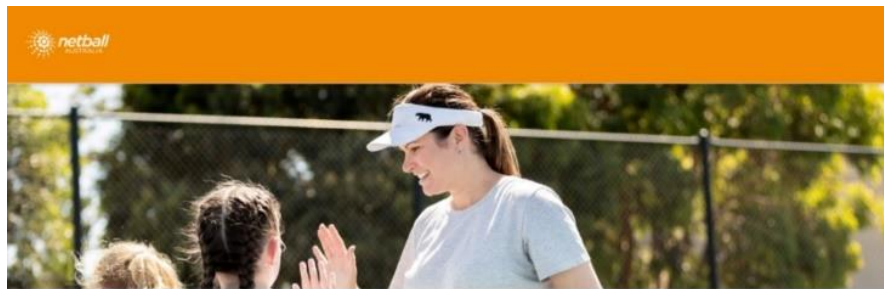

STEP ONE – ENROLLING IN THE ACCREDITATION

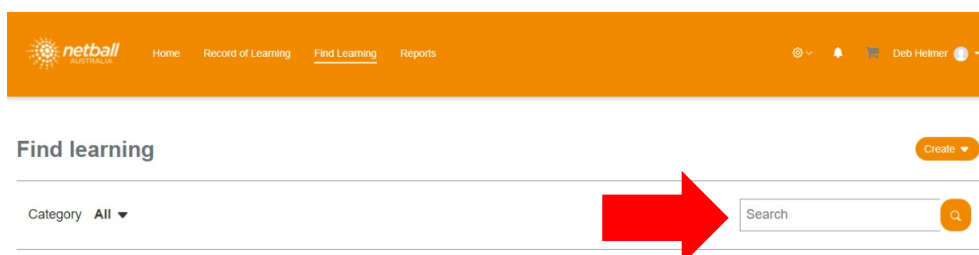
- Go to Netball Learning - <https://learning.netball.com.au>



C Badge Umpire Accreditation

About the C Badge Umpiring Accreditation

Congratulations on enrolling into the C Badge Umpiring Accreditation, the first step in the Umpiring pathway.

To be successful in achieving your 'C' badge, you must be able to display a basic grasp of game management skills, umpiring techniques and practical application of the rules to penalise obvious infringements. This is an **ENTRY-LEVEL BADGE ONLY** and testers should not expect a perfect display. To successfully pass the C Badge Practical Assessment, you must be rated as competent on all aspects of the assessable performance criteria.

Accreditation Outcomes

When you successfully obtain your C Badge accreditation, you will have/be able to:

- Basic game management skills to keep game moving and maintain player safety in low to average standard matches
- Basic procedural competence (late arrivals, failure to take the court, stoppages). Basic positioning and vision skills.
- Reactions/timing appropriate for low to average standard matches.
- Usually recognises and penalises obvious infringements, both major and minor.
- Applies 'advantage goal' so as not to disadvantage non-offending team.

Netball Australia Accreditations expire **4 years** from the date obtained and to maintain the accreditation you must complete the reaccreditation pathway and achieve **20 development points** prior to the accreditation expiry date. Netball Australia allows a 6-month grace period to obtain these points should your accreditation expire.

Practical Test - C Badge

Description

To successfully pass the C Badge Practical Assessment, umpires must be rated as competent on all aspects of the assessable performance criteria. Testers only need to write a comment if the umpire has not achieved competency for a particular performance criteria. If the ASSESSMENT DECISION is COMPETENT, additional comments may be made in the General Comments section. If the ASSESSMENT DECISION is NOT YET COMPETENT, the Testers need to outline the ACTION PLAN discussed with the umpire. The action plan statement should identify further training, development or assessment needs to assist the umpire to reach the competency standard. Completed assessment forms are to be sent to the respective Member Organisation, which will send a copy to the umpire.

What you'll need to demonstrate

Candidates for the 'C' badge should display a basic grasp of game management skills, umpiring techniques and practical application of the rules to penalise obvious infringements. This is an ENTRY-LEVEL BADGE ONLY and testers should not expect a perfect display.



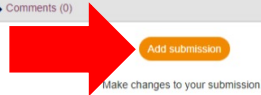

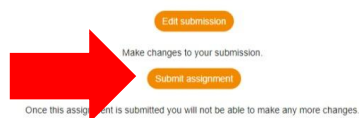
