Competition commencing : 15th July, 2024 held at Knox Regional Netball Centre, Indoor Courts
Team Entries: via this form – or through Netball connect - "Ladies spring competition – Monday night"

Penalty Loss of 4 premiership points may apply if the following is not adhered:
Teams must be financial – match fees and fines must be paid prior to playing.
An In-Eligible player listed on the scoresheet.

Forfeits/Walkovers:

\$160.00 PLUS a loss of 4 Premiership points for ALL forfeits/walkovers.

Teams giving a walkover SHOULD notify the Indoor Contact 0409174521 prior to the allocated playing time.

No team can take the court with fewer than 5 players.

The defaulting team shall be responsible for the imposed Walkover fees and the score (greater percentage for that section on that night) will be recognised and 4 points allotted accordingly.

Proof of age: All players must have turned 14 years of age to take the court.

Netball Victoria Membership: All players must self-register with Netball Victoria in 2024 through Netball Connect

Qualifying for Finals: Players must play in three (3) matches with your team in this season to qualify for finals.

General Information:

Teams will be graded during the first few weeks, all results will count towards premiership points. Fixtures will be available through Netball Connect App. All matches are played indoors at the Knox Regional Netball Centre. 9 Dempster Street, Ferntree Gully. Courts 1 and 2 (new stadium) First game 7.00 p.m.

Team responsibilities:

First named team shall be responsible for:

Providing an official scorer who must be 14 years or older.

Supply a match ball. Collect the scoresheet from the Supervisor. Please ensure BOTH teams have recorded each player's position for that match. Return completed scoresheet to the Supervisor after the match. Players will be considered "NOT" to have played if the position area next to their name is left unmarked.

Captains:

Shall toss prior to the match and inform the umpires of the result. May approach the umpires at a break for clarification of interpretations. Ensure team members are in correct matching uniform and nails etc. Please make all queries to your Supervisor - Do Not assume.

Official Scorer:

If the first named team cannot find anyone to score, they must stand a player off the court to score. We recommend the away team to have a person to sit with the scorer to check the recording of the score. Please ensure the opposing team is given sufficient time to fill in player positions. The score on the official scoresheet is final.

Registration of players:

All players need to be registered with Netball Victoria and Mountain District Netball Association "Ladies spring competition – Monday night"

In-Eligible Players:

Any team playing an in-eligible player shall lose four (4) premiership points. An In-eligible player is:

- A player who is named on any scoresheet twice on one night.
- A player being added to your team, who has not filled in the Player Registration Sheet.

Uniforms: Suitable sports shorts only – NO pockets or belts. Sleeveless tops may be worn, NO thin shoulder straps are allowed. Bike shorts can be worn but cannot show below your skirt/dress. Track pants or long bike pants or leggings **MAY NOT** be worn during play unless for religious or cultural reasons.

Jewellery: Only a plain flat wedding ring is allowed, and this must be taped, all other items to be removed.

Nails: Must be kept short and smooth. Long nails must be padded then taped, with two strips of soft tape - one over the top of the finger to the first joint and the other around the finger. No Gloves are permitted (without a Medical Certificate).

Body Piercing: Must be removed. If this cannot be done and it can be seen, then it must be suitably taped.

Injuries: All injuries must be reported to your Supervisor and a witness must sign the statement. Limited cover is available through your Netball Victoria Membership. Please check your current card for Insurers phone number and to obtain a claim form.

Blood: Bleeding players must come off the court immediately to be treated.

First Aid: Emergency supplies - ice is available. Please use the wheelchair for bad injuries therefore restricting further injury to yourself.

Stadium & Court areas: All players, spectators and club members are expected to behave in a responsible and thoughtful manner. Teams are expected to remove all rubbish from their area after the match is over. Chewing gum is not permitted. This centre is a smoke free area.
